

:: context

The city of Quarteira and the effects of sea level rising:

The sea as a dynamic element and the city as the result of sedimentation and metamorphosis;

The thickness of the urban margin between land and sea.

Expected climate change impacts on the Portuguese coastline urge a transformative action on urban waterfronts. In this context, it is proposed to question through the project, at different scales, how the metamorphosis of the urban margin of Quarteira in face of the expected rise in sea level and effects of coastal erosion can participate in the construction of the *material urbanity* that Manuel de Solà-Morales defined, through exploration of an idea of *relational architecture*, in continuity with the *locus* physical memory.

:: theme

Draw the permanence and imagine the transformation in a scenario of uncertainty:

Design the transformation of the public space on the seafront in continuity with the inherited city; Ordering the memory of architectural and urban elements facing climate change effects; Intertwin [entramar] the form of permanent elements and the temporality of ephemeral elements.










Water, form and project constitutes the triad which will lead to the interpretation and design of the urban margin transformation.

We aim to explore the importance of physical mater which carries the memory of the space and allows the continuity of city legibility. Support of the temporal needs of successive *civitas* generations which appropriate the *urbs* in time. The definition of spatial qualities which resist the test of time, its form and the control of its ambiguity, understood as the ability to adapt the limits of public space to different uses and occupations in time, both linear and cyclic.



:: design programme and structure

The design exercise departs from a synthesis between the site interpretative reading and the architectural and urban culture. Enriched by research and debate, it is explored a vision of the city which articulates theory and practice, reading and project, from the answer to a set of sequent stages with the aim to build the material urbanity of the spaces intertwined with the sea.

READING

The decoding of the seashore natural and anthropic imprints and fragments. The interpretation of the territory as a base for a *relational architecture* in the construction of the place.


CONCEPT


The systematization of an atlas of significant *architectural elements* and the formulation of the urban project strategy.




PROJECT

The design of urban architecture at different spatial scales and temporal dimensions, significant for the *material urbanity* of the of the seafront.










lab project IV [memory and project]

The urban strategy and the urban project of Quarteira's seafront in climate change context.


The design of the materiality and the constructivity of the proposed public space.






lab project V [public space continuity]


