





Common Ground


The proposed core exercise consists of **developing an urban–architectural project with a hybrid programme**, capable of articulating different uses while simultaneously **redesigning public space**.

The architectural project thus assumes a public value, projecting new spaces and reusing existing buildings, and is required to configure collective spaces that mediate between the city's public structure and the private domains of the building(s). Through the definition of ambiguous and shared spatial systems, the building incorporates a porosity that enables diverse modes of inhabitation and ensures integration with the surrounding urban context. The ground of the city merges with the ground of the building, expanding spaces, dissolving limits, and fostering places of encounter and sociability that regenerate the urbanity of the site.

Starting from a concrete reality with territorial attributes capable of stimulating the students' creative development, three exercises are proposed, each autonomous in nature yet interconnected within the continuity of the semester.





Between Lines


Starting from an urban design of wider territorial expression, it is intended to interpret urban porosity as a tool for integration between the built fabric and infrastructural axes of great morphological expression.


The Between Lines – river coatline; main street; railway – constitutes complex linear systems of circulation and living that intertwine in the built fabric reconfiguring the public space and the limits of the buildings, which causes transformations in the way we inhabit the city. The buildings emerges as a continuations of urban paths and the combination of both builds structures that integrate infrastructures and dissipate urban disruptions caused by them.
