OBJECTIVES: We aim to work in the context of **'Urban Renewal, Regeneration, and Requalification.'** The urban-architectural structures should comply with new buildings and interventions in pre-existing landscapes, urban areas, and built elements.

THEORETICAL APPROACH: The blend of presences and continuities, unlike the socially and spatially stratified city, will be one of the tracks of the Program and Design Proposal followed below. The importance of the Public Space, the rethinking of the Private Space, the couplings and continuities between both, in their materiality, in their social, cultural, and economic structures, in the context of Historical Continuity and Spatial Contiguity are key factors to consider. There is always a *Before* and an *After* in the City, but also a *Here* and a *There*. It is in this web that the City should be understood, studies, transformed.

QUESTIONS: Who will come to live in the neighborhood in the short and medium run, considering the conditions of its centrality and accessibility, bringing new populations? How to improve and potentiate the aspects of the local urban life? How to widen its attractiveness basing it on spreading of the possible public and collective uses? How to resolve and reinforce the **permeability / separation systems** that can be observed at the neighborhood's outskirts are key questions that make this work proposal and design make sense.

PROGRAMME PROPOSALS

Non-current housing typologies:

- Housing that is available to special strata of the population (elderly and people in 'non-active' age);
- Temporary housing, students, researchers, temporary workers;
- 'Co-housing and shared uses and facilities;
- Affordable housing for young people starting their independent life;
- Multi-family housing, diverse arrangements, and family growth in the units.

Social-cultural and economic uses:

- CO-WORKING / SMALL BUSINESS, Business Idea;
- Community activities for the volunteering of 'non-active' or active individuals;
- SOHO Small Business Home Office;
- Teaching / learning spaces, Ateliers;
- MULTI-USE Spaces;
- Local life support facilities;
- Public, urban, outdoor support uses;
- Other uses, from students' proposals.

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
