AT ALCALÁ'S OLD COURTYARDS

Urban Regeneration Work Shop September 3rd – 9th, 2018

This course will work on currently empty and out of use courtyards within historical buildings in Alcalá as a model for architectural regeneration. The scientific direction of the workshop selects several case studies from Alcalá, experimenting the architectural project as a tool to enhance the historical heritage and its regeneration. The aim is to contribute to the international culture of architecture with the extraordinary richness of historical buildings in this period of worldwide crisis and uncontrolled urban growth.

15 places are available to students enrolled in the universities of Alcalá, Lisboa and Sassari. Workshops will take place from September 3rd to September 9th, 2018 and they will be concluded with an exhibition of the students' work.

With these intensive workshop we provide student with the opportunity to make a practical experience concentrated in time and strongly focused on in-depth training objectives. To this end we invite students enrolled in this workshop to explore critically architectural regeneration as a set of applied collective activities of reusing, adapting and evolving existing buildings within an urban context, recognising the impacts these decisions and interventions have on the regeneration of a place, while being underpinned by the principles of environmental, social and cultural sustainability.


The participation of foreign teachers is foreseen.
